What is the Wood Patent?

That's the first point of this essay, ownership. This relates to how much do we think about God & what he created/ invented as well as what He owns.

"Who owns the patent on wood? God [Trinity]...

Genesis 1:11 "Then God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants, yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit after their kind, with seed in them, on the earth:; and it was so."

Colossians 1:16 "For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created by Him & for Him."

Second point, this relates to the question "Who worked with the very wood that He invented"? "Who was the carpenter & son of a carpenter"? ... Jesus ...

Mark 6:3 "Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, and brother of James, and Joses, and Judas, and Simon? Are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at Him.

[Matt 13:55 mentions Him also as the carpenter's son].

Third point... the crucifixion that is so central to our eternity? ... "Who died on the cross? The one that was made out of the same wood that He invented...?" ... Jesus ...

Luke 23:33, 46 "And when they came to the place called the Skull [Golgotha], there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left" ... "And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, INTO THY HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT.: And having said this, He breathed His last".
